Dr. Niti Ranjan Nag, aged 82, an alumnus of Bengal Engineering College (Metallurgy, 1961) passed away on December 11th 2020 in Kolkata.

Born in Barishal, erstwhile East Bengal; he spent his formative years in Kolkata having studied in Bangabasi College and then in Sanskrit college before joining the B.E. College, Shibpur.

Subsequently he travelled to United Kingdom, where he completed his Ph. D. from the University of Nottingham.

He spent few years as a Research Scientist in British Steel Corporation (now Tata Steel, UK) before returning to India where he joined the National Metallurgical Laboratory, CSIR, and worked there initially in Jamshedpur and then in Kolkata up to his retirement.

He was also instrumental in setting up METARCH, a NABL accredited laboratory with which he kept his voluntary association until the very end. He also had a long association with his Alma Mater, B.E. College,

where he gave invited lectures and remained an active member of the alumni community.

An avid traveller and full of zest for life, he will be deeply missed by his friends and family. He is survived by his wife, Sulagna Nag, son Kaushik and daughter Piyashi.
